GENERAL GUIDELINES

You can create a session and refine it based on peer feedback.

Sessions are possible with a maximum of 2 presenters. Any copresenter must be known and defined in the system before the call for sessions closes.

Submitting a session proposal and a review will happen via e-mail.

SESSION TYPES

For 2025 following types of events has been envisaged:

- Lectures (Interactive talk) An event at the main stage, where the lecturer (presenter) gives a presentation of approximately 35 minutes including 10 minutes that should be reserved for Q&A session.
- Workshops An event where the lecturer introduces the topics and participants have the opportunity to try the techniques themselves. Workshops should last up to 80 minutes.
- Experience report/case study May take place at any stage, depending on the topic attractiveness and slot availability. It should last approximately 35 minutes including 10 minutes that should be reserved for Q&A session.
- Engagements Small workshops, engaging meets, unconference topics, technique demonstrations and similar events. The idea for these events is that they happen in open space where anyone can join. They should be short, flexible, and highly engaging. They should provide participants with real-life examples of technique used or engage them in discussions on a particular topic. One engaging session should last 15-30 minutes and should engage around 10 people. The slot can't be longer than 1 hour.
- **Keynote** One keynote session is envisaged for the event. Keynote speakers will be invited based on the pre-selection process performed by the organizers.
